What: This will be an Easter egg drop event

When: July 26th, 2021 at 6:00pm

Where: Riverside Park and Wesley Park

Who: This event is for 100 kids at each park that were 0 - 5th grade at the end of the 2020/2021 school year. Registration is **REQUIRED** prior to the event, deadline to register will be July 16th, 2021. See below for registration information.

How: Participants will grab eggs from the designated area of the park that they were signed up for. Most eggs will be empty but some may contain prizes. Eggs will be exchanged for prize bags.

- 1) This event is for children 0-5th grade at the end of the 2020/2021 school year.
 - i. Registration is required and can be found on our website (www.muskegontwp.org)

 - iii. Registration will be open from June 23rd, 2021 through July 7th, 2021 but may close early if maximum number of registrants are reached.
 - iv. As this event will occur simultaneously at both parks, you may only participate at one park
- 2) All participants and their parents or guardians must follow all laws and ordinances.
- 3) Participants will find Easter eggs and exchange them at the prize table for a treat bag. Eggs should be returned and opened at the prize table as some will contain additional prizes.
- 4) Photos may be taken of your child participating in the event and may be used on Muskegon Townships social media, website or for other purposes to showcase the Muskegon Township parks.
