Definition of Temporary Structure: Any structure in use for 180 days or less.

Tents, canopies and awnings are considered a structure per International Building Code.

A permit is required for any temporary structure in excess of 120 sq. ft.

REQUIREMENTS

2Sets of drawings (minimum 11" x 17") required. Drawings must show the following:

- ✓ Setbacks distances from buildings and roads
- ✓ Detailed layout of tent <u>use</u>. ie what will be inside?
- ✓ Any other detached structures
- ✓ Tent location on property
- ✓ Road locations
- ✓ Means of egress (exits)
- ✓ Heating or electricity
- ✓ Fire extinguisher locations
- ✓ Note any sides to be enclosed

If separation distance of multiple tents is less than aggregate size.	ft., they constitute one		
No smoking signs must be posted.			
Exits must be clearly mark & clear of obstruction.			
Types of tents that require certification of flame resistance: any tent over 400 sq. ft. Occupant load to be determined by Building Official.
