ACCESSORY BUILDING

200 SQUARE FEET OR SMALLER MAYBE ERECTED WITHOUT A BUILDING PERMIT PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE REQUIREMENTS ARE FOLLOWED

- 1. Only two accessory buildings are allowed on your property, without Planning Commission Approval
- 2. All accessory buildings must be placed in the rear yard
- 3. The walls of a building 120 sq. ft. or less can be 3' from the rear property line and 3' from side property line
- 4. The walls of a building 121 sq. ft. or larger needs to be 10' from rear property line and 10' from side property line if connected to public sewer; 12' from property lines if **not** connected to public sewer
- 5. The distance between a detached accessory building and the main principal building shall not be less than 6' (foundation to foundation)
- 6. Building Official, Zoning Administrator, or Planning Commission must approve setbacks for all corner lots
- 7. Wood Floors, the floor framing and the plywood floor itself must be constructed entirely of pressure treated wood
- 8. All waterfront lots: please talk to the Zoning Administrator or the Building Official before constructing any accessory building
