

NOTICE TO RESIDENTS

Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Work

Muskegon Charter Township is currently cleaning, and doing video assessment of, the sanitary sewer system throughout the township. This work enables us to determine if any repairs are needed, as well as continuing to provide our residents with a clean and well maintained sanitary system.

LiquiForce services and their subcontractor **PipeTek** have been contracted by the Township to perform this work. The work will begin on March 5th 2018 and continue, until completion, which is estimated to be August 31st 2018. Most likely you will see these contractors working in your area for only a short time and then moving on to new pipe sections and out of your area within a couple of days, hours of operation for this work is from 7am to 7pm.

During work on the sewer some residents may or may not experience an odor coming from your drains or toilets, and possibly sounds coming from house drains. This can be minimized by keeping toilets lids closed and by pouring water into any house drains.
