Great things are happening in Muskegon Charter Township

An update from our township supervisor



The Veterans Memorial and Wall of Honor, behind township hall, is nearly complete. While work continues on landscaping and visual aesthetics we have been adding nameplates as they are ordered. If you would like to purchase a nameplate in memory, or in honor of, any honorably discharged veteran of the United States Armed Services you can find the order form online at www.muskegontownship.org or pick one up at township hall.

Muskegon Township has added 2 new vehicles to our fleet.

The fire department has taken delivery of a 2019 Spartan/Spencer fire apparatus. This new unit features an aluminum cab, all poly-propylene rear body and galvanized steel frame. It carries 2,000 gallons of water and has a pumping capacity of 1,500 gallons per minute. This unit is stationed at our Number 2 Station on N. Getty. It is equipped with emergency medical equipment, 900 feet of attack fire hose, 1,050 feet of large diameter supply hose, ladders, power tools and hand tools. It can transport up to 4 fire fighters. It's anticipated to serve the citizens of Muskegon Charter Township for more than 20 years.

Our Sanitation Department has begun using the 2019 Mack Side Load Sanitation Truck with a cart topper and loader. This new truck is equipped with a mechanical arm to allow our staff to work more safely and efficiently.

In order for the truck to work properly we ask that all Muskegon Township sanitation containers be placed with the arrows on the lids facing towards the street.
