As we near the end of 2018, I'd like to highlight some of the growth we have seen in Muskegon Township this year. North Port Villages has begun construction on 8 homes in this newly developed planned residential community. We're looking forward to watching the development grow and welcoming new residents to Muskegon Township.

Many new business licenses were issued in 2018. We have welcomed Planet Fitness, Abby Mays Fabric Shop, Papa Murphys, O'Reilly Auto Parts, Dollar General, Northside Nutrition, You Name It, The Bar and Plate Fitness Center, and Great Lakes Nutrition, to name a few. Christmas and New Year's Holiday Sanitation Collection Schedule

- Township offices will be closed on December 24 & 25 for the Holidays. Sanitation and Recycling service WILL NOT run on December 25 but WILL run on December 24 and collection will be one day later than normal for the rest of the week.
- Township offices will be closed on December 31 and January 1 for the Holidays. Sanitation service WILL NOT run on January 1 but WILL run on December 31. Collection will be one day later than normal for the rest of the week.
- Christmas tree pick up will be the week of January 7.

We Want Your.....Trash!



The cost of service includes trash removal, recycling removal, yard waste removal and removal of large items (sofas, recliners, mattresses, etc). Free access to the yard waste site is also included. We bill quarterly (every three months) and the cost is only \$49.00 per quarter.

To sign up for our service, stop in to Township Hall or go to our website and get the form there. You can print it out and mail it in, drop it in the night deposit box or email it to us.

Winter Reminders

- The snow season is almost here, make sure all cars are removed from the street during snowy conditions. This allows the Department of Public Works' snow plows to do a great job for the community.
- Snow plows forcefully throw snow and ice chunks several feet. Make sure your mailbox is securely fastened to the post. It must be able to withstand the force of the snow from the plows. Cars parked next to the road in unpaved road right-of-ways may be damaged by debris thrown off the plow. Cars should be parked in driveways.
- Call the non-emergency number for Central Dispatch, 231-722-3524, to report water main breaks or sewer problems after normal working hours.
- Contact the Muskegon Charter Township Police Department before you leave for vacation or head south for the winter. Officers can keep an eye on your house for you while you are away. Contact the department at 231-777-2555 Ext. 1117.
